## **Pikes Peak Lodge Guest Guide**

### **General Information**

Welcome to Pikes Peak Lodge. Our lodging office, Building 1042, is staffed 24 hours a day 7 days a week. Our courteous Guest Service Representatives are always on duty to assist you.

**BUSINESS CENTER:** We have two computers in the main lobby for guests to access the Internet, scan, fax and print at no charge. There is also Wireless Internet connection available in the main lobby. We ask that you limit your use to 30 minutes if guests are waiting.

**CHECK CASHING:** We can only accept checks for the amount of your service charges. If you need cash, there is an Automatic Teller Machine (ATM) located at the Shoppette Bldg 1700 and the Base Exchange Bldg 2017 or one of the two banks located at the Main gate (Five Star Bank and ENT Federal Credit Union).

**CHECK IN/OUT TIMES:** Check-in time is **1400**; Check-out time is **1100**. If you must check out after 1100 hours, contact the front desk for approval, otherwise you will be charged an additional lodging fee.

**COMPLIMENTARY BEVERAGES:** Coffee, tea, and condiments are provided for your enjoyment free of charge. Your housekeeper will replenish them daily. There is also complimentary coffee and hot chocolate provided at the front desk.

**DO NOT DISTURB SIGNS:** These signs are provided for your convenience. Simply slip the sign into the exterior key slot to your room. If you would like to receive housekeeping service, we ask that you remove the "Do Not Disturb" sign by 1300 hrs. Regardless, on the third day that the "Do Not Disturb" sign is left without prior arrangements with the Lodging Manager, housekeeping must enter your room to ensure everything is satisfactory and you are safe.

**EXCESS CLEANING FEE:** Guests may be charged a cleaning fee up to \$150 based on the expenses incurred to return the room to available inventory.

**FAXING SERVICES:** Local or DSN fax service is available at the front desk at no cost.

#### **FIRE SAFETY:**

- ❖ Do not smoke or use any tobacco products in the rooms.
- ❖ Flammable liquids (gasoline, charcoal lighter, cleaning fluid, etc.) are not allowed on lodging property.
- ❖ Additional cooking / heating devices (space heaters, hot plates, propane tanks) are not allowed in the rooms and will be removed if found without notification to the guest.
- ❖ Never leave heated cooking appliances unattended.
- ❖ Do not place hot appliances (irons, blow dryers, coffeepots, etc.) in drawers or cabinets.
- ❖ Do not overload electrical outlets. Multi-plugs and power strips are therefore prohibited.
- ❖ Do not leave electrical appliances on when unattended.
- ❖ Practice good housekeeping (clean-up messes; bag any dirty clothes; keep wet clothes away from heat sources).

- ❖ Do not burn candles, potpourri, or incense in rooms. If found these items will be removed without notification to the guest.
- ❖ Vacate all rooms during fire alarms. Evacuation routes are posted on back of main door if the room does not exit to the outside and is above ground level.

**FITNESS CENTER:** The fitness center is located in building 560, phone# 556-4462. More details on the location of the Fitness Center are located in the base map in the Maps section of this directory. We also have a fitness room with cardio equipment in building 1143 for lodging guest use.

**HOUSEKEEPING SERVICES:** Housekeeping service is provided seven days a week (unless you post a “Do Not Disturb” sign on your door). The housekeeper will return at 1300 to service your room. If the sign is still on your door at 1300, service will not be provided. Bed linens will be changed once a week for long term guests, unless otherwise requested. Towels and washcloths will be replaced as you choose. On holidays and days of inclement weather housekeeping services are minimal. In the spirit of being environmentally conscious if you would like to re-use your towels, please hang them on the towel rack. If you would like clean towels, please place soiled towels on the floor and we will exchange them. More details of the housekeeping services you will receive are located in the Lodging Info section of this directory.

**IN ROOM SAFES:** It is the responsibility for guests to safeguard their belongings. For your convenience we have placed a safe in every room. The safe can be locked with a 3 to 6 digit numeric code of your choosing or by using a credit card.

**IRONS AND IRONING BOARDS:** These are provided in each room. If your iron or ironing board is missing or not working properly, please notify the front desk by dialing 0 from your room.

**LAUNDRY ROOMS:** All laundry machines are free of charge for lodging guests. Soap, bleach, and softener are available for sale in the laundry room and at the front desk. We ask you to please leave the laundry room clean. The locations of the laundry facilities for each building are listed below. **The use of liquid bleach is prohibited in all lodging facilities and will be removed without notification to the guest if found.**

**LOST AND FOUND:** Items which are left behind will be held for 30 days in our lost and found storage. After 30 days the item will be disposed of. Any perishable items and under garments will be disposed of immediately.

**FORGOT YOUR PHONE CHARGER:** Turns out that's an *extremely* common mistake - call or stop by the front desk we might have one that you can have for FREE!

**MAIL:** Pikes Peak Lodge does not accept personal mail. Outgoing mail can be dropped off at the Post Office (Bldg. 1466). Postage stamps are available for purchase at the front desk.

**MESSAGES:** A flashing red light on your phone indicates you have a message waiting. Please dial 6000 or the message button to retrieve your messages.

**OTHER SERVICES:** Baby cribs and highchairs may be obtained from the front desk.

**PARKING:** One parking space per room is provided in the parking lots adjacent to all our quarters. If you have additional or oversized vehicles please see the Front Desk for assistance with overflow parking. **Vehicle(s) should only be parked in designated parking areas. Do not park on the grass or on the front porch.** Vehicles in violation of this policy will be towed by order of the Base Commander and the Security Police. Oversized vehicle parking is directly across Glasgow Street from Bldgs 1026 & 1030 in the Club Parking Lot.

**PET POLICY:** Pets are only allowed in our “pet friendly” rooms, and not in any other transient facilities. There is an extra fee of \$10 per night and a limit of 2 pets per unit. Pets will not be kept in cages outside, tied to trees, nor kept in automobiles. Pet owners must sign a pet agreement at check-in and provide a copy of updated shot records. A pet cleaning fee of \$150 will be assessed to guests who violate the pet policy. A list of local kennels is provided for your convenience in this directory under the General Info tab and at the Front Desk upon request. Please see the front desk for pet policy guidelines to further answer any questions or concerns.

**SMOKING POLICY:** Pikes Peak Lodge is smoke-free facility to include smokeless tobacco and smoke free cigarettes. This includes all common areas. Guests who violate this policy will be assessed a \$150 cleaning fee, which includes blocking the room and cleaning until all evidence of smoke is eliminated. Please locate the designated smoking areas near your building.

**SUNDRY ITEMS:** If you have forgotten any toiletry items, we have a selection at the front desk for purchase. We also have snacks, sodas, alcohol and other miscellaneous items available.

**SUPPLIES AND LINEN:** If you need extra supplies/linen, please contact the housekeepers or front desk. Please do not take items off the housekeeping cart. Housekeepers are held accountable for the supplies on their carts and must keep a record of replenishments.

**TELEPHONE INSTRUCTIONS:** Instructions on using the telephone are located in the Telephone Info section of this directory and also in a stand near the telephone.

**TV & DVD RECEPTION/REPAIR:** If the TV or DVD player in your room malfunctions, please notify the front desk. We will try to repair or replace the piece of equipment as soon as possible. For inventory and resource protection reasons, we cannot move equipment from room to room.

## OCCUPANT RESPONSIBILITIES

The following are provided for your guidance and to ensure a comfortable and safe environment for all our guests and staff:

- ❖ *Please do not write in this directory.*
- ❖ Please observe quiet hours 2200 to 0600 daily
- ❖ Liquid bleach and liquid shoe polish/shoe dressing are not allowed on the premises of any Lodging facility and will be removed if found without notification to the guest.
- ❖ Bicycles, auto parts, etc., may not be kept in the rooms. Bicycles may not be locked to entrance stairways, or other stationary objects. Please use available bike racks.
- ❖ Please do not rearrange the furniture.
- ❖ All lodging guests are required to clean the stove, refrigerator and dishes before check-out. There will be a \$25 cleaning fee for any utensils left in the sink. Guests in TLFs may place silverware and dishes in dishwashers without any fees assessed.
- ❖ Do not place hot appliances (i.e. irons or coffee pots) on the furniture or carpet.
- ❖ Additional cooking / heating devices (space heaters, hot plates) are not allowed in the rooms unless provided by lodging and will be removed if found without notification to the guest.
- ❖ Damage to the room or furnishings will result in an additional replacement fee.
- ❖ Do not overload electrical circuits by using multi-plugs and extension cords.
- ❖ For safety/energy conservation please turn off lights, TV, etc., when you leave the room.
- ❖ Report accidents and spills to the front desk so they can be taken care of quickly.
- ❖ Allow housekeeping access to your room. For safety reasons housekeepers are required to enter all quarters every **third day**, regardless of a “Do Not Disturb” sign on the door. “Do Not Disturb” rooms will be checked after 1300 hrs on the third day.
- ❖ Keep your valuables safe and secure. For your convenience we have provided locking safes in all our rooms. Money or high value items left lying around the room will be reported to management and service will not be provided.
- ❖ Pets are prohibited, except in the “pet friendly” rooms. A \$150 cleaning fee will be assessed for pets found in non pet friendly rooms. Kennel information is listed in the General Info section of this directory. Note: Pet rooms will be serviced daily.
- ❖ Report, register, and store weapons with the Peterson AFB Security Forces. Weapons and ammunition are not permitted in rooms. For storage of these items please contact Security Forces at 556-4000.
- ❖ A cleaning fee up to \$150 may be assessed to return the room to standard.
- ❖ Housekeeping staff are not permitted to move your personal belongings to clean. If items are left on beds or floors housekeepers will not be able to provide service. Trash not placed on/in trash receptacles will not be taken out until your departure.
- ❖ Please respect your neighbors and keep your TV or radio volume at a level where it will not interrupt other guests.
- ❖ No smoking/smokeless tobacco in any room or common area. There will be a \$150 cleaning fee to guests who violate this policy.
- ❖ Please do not leave laundry unattended and please leave the facility clean.
- ❖ Guest will be charged market value plus a handling fee for any items missing or damaged such as utensils, hangers, towels, etc.
- ❖ If you encounter a maintenance or housekeeping problem please contact the front desk right away so that we can correct any discrepancies immediately and ensure the rest of your stay is enjoyable.
- ❖ If there is anything that the staff can do to make your stay more comfortable, please let us know.

## PAYMENT PROCEDURES

- ❖ Guests checking in will sign the guest registration form that advises them lodging is authorized to apply any unpaid charges to their credit card.
- ❖ All long term guests (staying over 15 days), whether paying by cash, check, or credit card, will return to the front desk at 15-day intervals to verify and pay their lodging bill or pay in advance for the next 15 days.
- ❖ Cash/check-paying guests must pay in advance for the next 15 days or remaining days of occupancy (if less than 15 days)
- ❖ Credit card-paying guests will have their credit card processed for charges incurred over the previous 15 days.
- ❖ All space available guests, regardless of method of payment, will pay for their stay in advance at check in. Advance payment will be required for any approved extension.

## CHECK-IN TIME

# PETERSON HISTORY



**Lt Edward J. Peterson**

Peterson AFB traces its roots to the Colorado Springs Army Air Base, established on May 6, 1942 at the Colorado Springs Municipal Airport, which had been in operation since 1926. The base carried out photo reconnaissance training under the auspices of the Photo Reconnaissance Operational Training Unit (PROTU). On June 22, 1942, Colorado Springs Army Air Base was assigned to the 2nd Air Force, headquartered at Fort George Wright, Washington.

Then, after only a few weeks, a tragedy occurred that would indelibly affect the base. On Aug. 8, 1942, First Lieutenant Edward J. Peterson, Operations Officer for the 14th Photo Reconnaissance Squadron and a native of Colorado, crashed while attempting to take off from the airfield when the left engine of his twin engine F4 (a reconnaissance variant of the P-38 Lightning) failed. A base fire department crew rescued Lt. Peterson from the burning wreckage. Unfortunately, Lt. Peterson sustained significant burns and died at a local hospital that afternoon, thereby becoming the first Coloradan killed in a flying accident at the airfield. Consequently, on Dec. 13, 1942, officials changed the name of the Colorado Springs Army Air Base to Peterson Army Air Base in honor of the fallen airman.

In the spring of 1943, the base assumed a new mission - that of heavy bomber combat crew training. The 214th Combat Crew Training School conducted the training utilizing the B-24 Liberator. From March 5 to Oct. 1, 1943, Peterson Field, as the base was commonly called,



was assigned to the 3rd Air Force headquartered at Greenville Army Air Base, South Carolina. Control of Peterson Field then reverted to the 2nd Air Force. In June 1944 the mission at the base once again changed, this time to fighter pilot training.

The 72nd Fighter Wing assigned to the base employed P-40 Warhawks to carry out this mission. In April 1945, Peterson Field was assigned to Continental Air Forces. The location of the Army Air Forces Instructors School at the base signaled another mission change. A short time later, on Dec. 31, 1945, the Army inactivated the base, turning the property over to the city of Colorado Springs.



The legacy of Peterson Field and the military presence in Colorado Springs took a significant turn in September 1947 following the birth of the United States Air Force. Soon after its inception, the fledgling service twice reactivated the base from Sept. 29, 1947 to Jan. 15, 1948 and again from Sept. 22, 1948 into 1949. During the latter period, the base served as an airfield for Headquarters, 15th Air Force, which had been temporarily located in Colorado Springs. Peterson Field inactivated again when the 15th Air Force moved to March Air Force Base in 1949.

The Air Force activated Peterson Field once more, following the January 1951 establishment of Air Defense Command at Ent AFB located in downtown Colorado Springs. The 4600th Air Base Group activated simultaneously on Jan. 1, 1951, and provided support for the newly established command. In 1958 the 4600th achieved wing status and was designated as the 4600th Air Base Wing. Subsequently, on April 1, 1975, the Air Force redesignated the wing as the 46th Aerospace Defense Wing. One year later, on March 1, 1976, Peterson Field was renamed Peterson Air Force Base.

Strategic Air Command assumed control of the base on Oct. 1, 1979. Then, on Sept. 1, 1982, USAF officials activated Air Force Space Command at Peterson, followed by the activation of the 1st Space Wing on Jan. 1, 1983. Peterson Air Force Base became the hub of Air Forces space activity when the 1st Space Wing assumed host unit responsibility following the inactivation of the 46th Aerospace Defense Wing on April 1, 1983. The 1st Space Wing then transferred host unit responsibility to the 3rd Space Support Wing, which activated on Oct. 15, 1986. Finally, on May 15, 1992, these two wings inactivated and their personnel and equipment transferred to the 21st Space Wing which activated on May 15, 1992.
